Groups Women started to know their rights from weekly meetings and discussion. Presently SBSS working in the field of Disaster management, Poverty alleviation, Training, Education, Agriculture, Water and Sanitation, Health & Nutrition, Advocacy, Legal Assistance & Arbitration, Technical Support Program with assistance from community people, local government, GOB officials and Donors.

Program Brief:

➤ Haor Elaker Subidha Banchito Narir Orthonaitik O Samajik Khamatayaner Jonno Aye O Karmoshangstan Brriddhi Kormosuchi:

The Main activities are: Establishment of Floating Vegetable Yard, Duck Rearing for under Privilege Women of 5 Haor Districts such as Sunamganj, Habiganj, Kishoreganj, Netrokona, Brammhanbaria



➤ Vocational Training on Motor Cycle Repairing under Haor Infrastructure & Livelihood Improvement Project (HILIP):

The main purpose of the project is to reduce the proportion of the country's rural population below the poverty line through improved access to markets and social services. This will be achieved by creating job placement and self-employment opportunities for the removing peoples in the Haor area. Besides, it also understood from the advertisement published by the concerned authority that the project has been allocated fund under the project activities and development component including the operational plan of activities. The main task/assignment of the service providing organization under this



project is to provide the Vocational Training on Motor Cycle Repairing to the removing people to reduce dependency on rice and fisheries as the main livelihood in the Haor. It is also understood that the project will select organization to implement project activities in 28 upazilas under the 5 Haor based districts namely B-Baria, Kishoreganj, Habiganj, Netrokona and Sunamganj respectively.

➤ IT/ICT Program:

Learning and Earning Development Project (LEDP) under the Ministry of Post, Telecommunication and Information Technology has been conducted satisfactorily in Magura & Comilla District in 2018 at Union Level for women as to empower the rural women for achieving the goal of Digital Bangladesh. The main objective of this project is to develop rural people precisely rural women as freelancers and to subtract unemployment from our nation. The conducted training programs were as follows: Basic IT/ICT Literacy



Training Program for Women at Union Level; Basic IT/ICT Literacy Training program for Freelancers at Union/Upazila Level, Search Engine Optimization (SEO) and Blogs & Article writing, Graphics & Multimedia: Adobe Illustrator, Adobe Photoshop, Adobe in Design Ges Quark Xpress. Advance IT/ICT Specialized Outsourcing Training for freelancers at Union/Upazila.. (Search Engine Optimization (SEO))

➤ The Capacity Development of Selected Destitute Women Crews in Cash for Work (CFW) Component under Rural Employment and Road Maintenance Programme (RERMP-2)

The main activities of the project is Income generation and business skills development training for ultra poor family beneficiaries

Skills development training on practical nutrition, homestead vegetable production and hygiene for female beneficiaries

Training on practical nutrition and reproductive health for adolescent girls, newlywed women and young mothers in 3052 unions

Identification and referral of severely malnourished babies, children under 5 years and pregnancy mother and lactating women in 3052 unions

Training on social awareness raising program for 33052 ultra poor women beneficiaries

Training on education drive to encourage primary-school age children of RERMP-2 beneficiaries in 3052 unions to attend school

➤ Venerable Groups and their Dependents (VGD) Program

Society for Bright Social Services (SBSS) has carried out of **Venerable Groups and their Dependents (VGD) Program** in Sunamganj Dwarabazar, Biwsumberpure upazilla of Sumanganj District and Lalpur, Bagatipara upazilla of Nator District of Bangladesh. **SBSS** has been involved in a vast range of VGD program with successfully implementation in different areas of Bangladesh in partnership with



government and other organizations. These project implementations was smooth and successfully. VGD program are funded by WFP/ FAO through Department of Women Affairs under Ministry of Women and Children Affairs of GOB. Duration of the project is August 2011 to till date. The main objectives and activities is base line survey to determine number and level of the target group, findings of the survey and prioritize, list out potential members for forming group, to provide awareness raising courses with an aim to enhance their knowledge and provide skill training and capital support for fitting them in IG program, to form group with 10 member in each group, to provide orientation and awareness raising sessions, to select group leaders through election, to phase out the project to the CBO, Monitoring, supervision, evaluation, follow-up, Report Preparation & Submission

➤ Human Rights, Woman and Child Rights Program:

SBSS puts emphasis on Human Rights Program to increase the awareness on Human Rights movement at community and policy levels. Organizes awareness sessions and trainings on different Human Rights issues especially women and child rights.

Objectives:

- To increase the awareness of individuals, families and society on overall Human Rights, woman and child rights issues.
- To advocacy with policy levels
- To provide legal supports to the beneficiaries

Activities:

- Organize training, workshop, seminar, sessions and campaign program to make people aware on Human Rights, woman and child rights issues
- Conduct advocacy meetings with different stakeholders
- Provide legal support to the beneficiaries

➤ Water and Sanitation:

SBSS puts emphasis on Water and Sanitation Management Program to increase the awareness on Primary health care and WATSAN to ensure disease free environment at community level. This program has been considerate as a significant component of the organization. Organizes awareness sessions and trainings on different primary health care issues, motivates beneficiaries for using safe drinking water and installation of water sealed latrines.



Objectives:

- To increase the awareness of individuals, families and society to combat health problems
- To reduce health hazards at public life
- To increase competence and capacity at individual and family life to encounter health hazards
- To improve the status of services among affected people
- To prevent preventable diseases

Activities:

- Organize training, workshop, seminar, sessions and campaign program to make people aware on health, water and sanitation.
- Facilitate people to set up latrines and tube-well and to change behavioral practices
- Ensure medical services for protesting water born diseases
- Increase coordination and collaboration among the service providing organizations and institutions

➤ Non- Formal Education Program:

Education is considered a basic necessity and the most important tool to develop people's mind and create awareness. The deprivation of a vast majority people from the right to education is an impediment to economic, social, political and cultural development.

SBSS main concern is to enable the poor to understand their situation and to be aware of their rights. If the right to basic education is ensured, the poor can be aware of their rights and can mobilize themselves to assert their rights.

Objectives:

- To increase the adult literacy for non literate group members
- To develop post-literacy centers for the neo-literates to reinforce, regenerate and sustain literacy skills
- To increase the enrolment of children of the poor households to enhance further growth o literacy
- To setup non-formal primary education (NFPE) for the dropped-out and non-enrolled children of 8-11 age group



Activities:

- Adult literacy for non literate group members
- Post-literacy centers for the neo-literates to reinforce regenerate and sustain literacy skills
- Enrolment of children of the poor households to enhance further growth o literacy
- Non-formal primary education (NFPE) for the dropped-out and un enrolled children of 8-11 age group

⇒ Advocacy Program:

Advocacy is considered the most important and as cross cutting issue to create positive attitude on different development issues. SBSS main concern is to aware policy levels as well as the implementer levels so that enable the target people to exercise their rights properly.

- To advocacy with the media for strengthen the advocacy issue
